Candidates must hold a PhD and have research experience in one or several of the following areas:

- Signal Processing
- Machine Learning
- Information Theory

The duration of the contract is one year, with the possible extension for another year, under the terms and conditions of employment established by the Universidad Carlos III de Madrid.

Candidates are expected to contribute to the group's research activities, both by participating in existing projects and initiatives and by driving new ones.
